For Employees to Quarantine SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL  
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This Sixth Supplemental Administrative Order is issued in response to Richland County being placed on Level 3 emergency status related to the COVID-19 pandemic. To the extent the new order conflicts with any prior order, the new order applies. All prior orders not inconsistent with this order shall remain in effect. The orders related to quarantine are general in nature and subject to the discretion of the Judge for individual cases.

1. Employees who test positive for COVID-19 shall quarantine for 10 days if there are mild or no symptoms. Employees shall not return to work until the employee's fever has been gone for 24 hours.
2. Employees who test positive for COVID-19 shall quarantine for 14 days if severe symptoms exist. Employees shall not return to work until the employee's fever has been gone for 24 hours.
3. Employees who are exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 but remains asymptomatic, shall quarantine for 10 days from the date of exposure. The employee may end quarantine and return to work after 7 days if the employee shows no symptoms and obtains a negative test, or a test which shows the presence of COVID-19 antibodies, based on a sample collected not before the 5<sup>th</sup> day of quarantine. Such employees should continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days.

This order shall be served on all court staff by e-mail.
